1. CODE REGISTRY

Made of microperforated and folded sandpaper.

STORAGE RULES:

Dry location with constant temperature between -10°C and +60°C.

2. DESCRIPTION

Roll of special sandpaper, microperforated and folded.

Both sides were sanded in order to achieve better adhesion to the plasterboard filler used.

The tape has been microperforated using an electrical device for better levelling when the plaster is applied.

It is folded in the middle for easy positioning of the tape.

3. USE

Used to join straight or concave joints between plasterboard sheets (partition walls and ceilings).

4. LAYING INSTRUCTIONS

- \cdot Make sure the working surface is clean (no dust or grease).
- Use a smoothing trowel. Cover the area to be joined between the 2 plasterboards with 3 mm of levelling compound.
- · Apply micro-perforated paper. Remove excess levelling compound with the trowel. Cover with finishing compound.
- Once dry, sand with an abrasive.

Temperature range: 5°C to 30°C.
